CEOs Club chapter to be opened in city

HYDERABAD: The Chief Executive Officers (CEO's) Club, a prestigious association of Heads of Fortune 500 companies in the world, is setting up its Indian chapter at Hyderabad. It will be inaugurated on March 7.
